Important: In this session, only new students enrolled specifically for Malta will be able to register. Students from Spain, may use this location only for recovery exams, not for their first attempt.









- **Limited spots**: Each exam has a maximum of 28 available spots. We recommend registering in advance to secure your place.
- Absence from the first attempt: If you miss your first scheduled exam, it will still be counted as an attempt, leaving you with only one recovery opportunity.
- Absence from the second attempt (recovery): If you miss your recovery exam, you will lose your right to a new presentation. To reprogram the exam, you must pay a fee of 300 Euros, subject to availability.
- Force majeure exceptions: In case of illness, accident, or the death of a close family member, a formal and duly supported justification must be submitted.
- **Exam Registration:** You are now required to register for the exams you wish to take through the new study platform. This step is mandatory to ensure your participation in the selected sessions.
- Payments: Students who are not up to date with their payments will not be allowed to sit for the exam.
- Exam language: All exam questions and answers are written in English.
- In-person review before the exam: as part of our commitment to your learning process, we offer a brief in-person review session before each exam. This is a focused time to go over key concepts and answer specific questions.

This session does not replace individual study nor the full content available on the platform, where you will find:

- -Live Online Classes and Pre-recorded classes (1 to 2 hours per module)
- -Books
- -Quizzes (based on the module content but may differ in structure from the official exam. Keep in mind that 360 Aviation Life does not have access to the actual exam questions).
- Review sessions for make-up exams outside the schedule: Exams taken as make-ups and not listed in the official schedule will not include a review session.
- In such cases, students must rely on the materials available on the platform.
- Each student is responsible for: Actively participating in sessions Attending live online classes Making the most of available resources Asking questions when needed.
- Make-up exams: If a make-up exam is requested by only one student and is not included in the official schedule, it will not be held. In such cases, the student must wait until the next scheduled session for that exam.
- **Exam Location:** Please note that the locations where the exams will be held are subject to change. The 360 Aviation Life team will confirm these details in advance, so make sure to stay updated through the official communication channels.
- Results delivery time: Results will be sent within 1 to 2 business days after the exam date.
- Certificates for passed exams will be sent only to students who are up to date with their payments.
