Barcelona, September 16, 2025 – 360 Aviation Life, a global reference in EASA Part 66 training and certification, has announced the launch of a new exam location in Malta, consolidating the island’s role as one of the fastest-growing aviation hubs in the Mediterranean and reinforcing the company’s mission to make European standards accessible worldwide.

The **new Malta location** will host its first EASA Part 66 B1 & B2 exam session from February 11th to 14th, 2026, followed by a second session from June 17th to 21st, 2026.
